

Miami Valley Peace Maker Award

1. Award Description

The Miami Valley Peace Maker Award is a tribute to individuals who have made outstanding yet often unrecognized contributions to fostering peace and nonviolence in their communities. This award serves as a platform to amplify the untold stories of these exceptional individuals, encouraging others to reflect on the importance of peace and the power of collective action. By celebrating their achievements, the award inspires hope, unity, and a deeper commitment to building a more harmonious world. Recipients are honored with a beautifully crafted commemorative trophy, symbolizing their lasting impact on their communities and beyond.

2. Eligibility Criteria

- Age: Open to individuals of all ages.
- Residency: There are no restrictions on the residency/ citizenship status of the Nominees. Please note that the International Peace Museum cannot provide accommodation in the case such is needed.
- Contributions: Nominees should have demonstrably advanced peace, nonviolence, or conflict resolution through community service, activism, education, or related efforts.

3. Nomination Process

- Nominations: Accepted from individuals aged 18 or older. Self-nominations are permitted.
- **Submission:** Complete the official nomination form available on the International Peace Museums Website.
- **Deadline:** All nominations must be submitted by the specified deadline. Late submissions will not be considered.

4. Selection Process

- **Review Committee:** A panel appointed by the awarding organization will evaluate all eligible nominations.
- Criteria: Selections are based on the impact, innovation, and sustainability of the nominee's peace-promoting activities.
- Notification: Award recipients will be notified by email or phone and announced publicly at the award ceremony.

5. Award Presentation

- **Ceremony:** The award will be presented during the Season for Nonviolence, observed annually from January 30 to April 4.
- Attendance: Both the nominator and the nominee are required to attend the award ceremony. The exact date and time will be shared in a timely manner with all participants.

6. General Conditions

- Publicity: By accepting the award, recipients agree to the use of their name, likeness, and information about their contributions for promotional purposes related to the award.
- **Non-Transferability:** The award is non-transferable and cannot be exchanged for cash or other substitutes.
- Disqualification: The awarding organization reserves the right to disqualify any nominee found to have provided false information or engaged in conduct unbecoming of a Peace Maker.
